



VISIT ORIENTATION.SA.UCSB.EDU The Pollock Theater CARSEY-WOLF Big Screen: Wakanda Forever and Indigenous Worldbuilding with Gerardo Aldana, Giovanni Batz and Daina Sanchez (Chicana and Chicano Studies, UCSB) Tuesday, January 24, 2023 / 7:00 PM Pollock Theater, UCSB Black Panther: Wakanda Forever (2022) introduces a new element into the Marvel Cinematic Universe: the undersea nation of Talokan, whose people are descended from an ancient Mayan community. Protected and guided by the powerful mutant Namor (Tenoch Huerta Mejía), the Talokanil have been forced to defend their sovereignty after invaders have tried to extract vibranium located in their homelands. As the Wakandans are consumed with mourning the death of T'Challa, their king, Namor arrives to alert them to a threat facing both of their nations. Professor Gerardo Aldana of UCSB's Department of Chicana and Chicano Studies served as a consultant on the film's representation of Mesoamerican cultures and played the role of UN assembly chairperson in the film. In a special post-screening discussion, Aldana will join Professors Giovanni Batz and Daina Sanchez, also of the Department of Chicana and Chicano Studies, for a discussion of the process of Indigenous worldbuilding and the politics of representation. The discussion will be moderated by Professor Cristina Venegas (Film and Media Studies, UCSB).
